

The Swedish Recorder Quartet

The Swedish Recorder Quartet was formed in 1993 and is made up of four of Sweden's foremost recorder players. They were all trained at the Royal College of Music in Stockholm. A host of Swedish composers have written and arranged music directly for the ensemble. In addition to newly written works, the group's repertoire includes compositions from the golden age of the recorder - the Renaissance and the Baroque. Over the years the quartet has embarked a number of acclaimed tours commissioned by Swedish Country Music Boards in addition to a tally of festival appearances and recording sessions for the Swedish Broadcasting Company and Swedish Radio.
